

PROFILE OF THE COLLEGE

VKV Government Degree College, Kothapeta was established in 1979 in the name of Viswa Kavi Vemana who is popularly known as Praia Kavi-poet of the People. It is affiliated to Adikavi Nannaya University. Up to 1979, higher education was a distant dream for these rural people. The youth of this area had to go either to Rajahmundry or Amalapuram for higher education. At the time of inception, the college had two programmes of study viz., B.A(Economics, History and Political science) and B.Com. In the year 1985-86, two science programmes B.Sc (Mathematics, Physics and Chemistry) and B.Sc(Botany,Zoology and chemistry) were added. The college is in its 43rd year of Existence. At present the college offered 7 programmes B. A(HEP),B.A(HET),B.Com (Gen),B.Com(CA),B.Sc(MPC),B.S.c(MPCs) and B.Sc(BZC). In 1998 Dr. B.R.Ambedkar Study centre was opened by the then honourable minister for Higher Education, Sri GMC Bala yogi. The college provides good infrastructure facilities such as well stocked Library, Well equipped lab, beautiful plantation, Hostel accommodation. Government (VKV) Degree College has professionally trained and highly qualified faculty. The college provides guaranteed placements facilities to the students. She worked to abolish the discrimination and unfair treatment of people based on caste and gender. She is regarded as an important figure of the social reform movement in Maharashtra.





NATIONAL GIRL CHILD DAY HISTORY






