Analysis on Student Satisfaction Survey (SSS) 2023-2024.

Introduction: Student Satisfaction Survey (SSS) is structured with 21 questions and administrated among the students in the College. This Feedback questionnaire forms are placed in various departments in the college. Students can access the, SSS in all working days of the stipulated period. The thrust area of questions ranges from curriculum, Teaching-Learning process, Evaluation procedures emphasizing on the teaching methods and procedures adopted. These questions are scaled on a five-point scale."0" is the least grade while 4 is the higher grade. The last 21 question is an open-end question obtaining the students' observation or suggestions for further enhancement of their satisfaction. During the year 2023-2024, the SSS was conducted for all 13 UG courses in the months of February 2024 and March 2024 and analyzed by IQAC in coordination with Feedback Committee.

Preliminary Analysis on the feedbacks received:

- A total of 240 responses were collected by March 2024. of which 20.83(50) percent of I-year students, 37.5(90) percent of II-year students and 41.66 (100) percent students from III year were participated.
- Out of the total 240 responses 54.16 (130) percent submitted for the first time and 45.83(110) percent submitted for the second time.
- Out of the 240 responses 60.41 (145) percent were male and 39.58(95) percent were females and 68(40) percent were pursuing their under graduation.
- Stream wise analysis projects that 29.16(70) percent responses were from Arts,12.5(30) percent responses from Commerce Stream and 58.33(140) percent responses from science stream.

QUESTION WISE ANALYSIS

Q1: Syllabus Coverage in the class:

Analysis: 238 students responded that 99.16 percent syllabus is covered.

Q2. Teachers prepare for the class.

Analysis: 99.16 percent students responded through preparation for class by faculty and **0.83** percent of them expressed satisfaction in the preparedness of the faculty to the class.

Q3. Teachers' Communication ability.

Analysis: **99.58** percent of the students expressed that the teacher's communication was always effective. **0.41** percent felt sometimes teachers' communication ability as somewhat effective.

Q4. Teachers' approach to teaching.

Analysis:99.16 percent of the students rated excellent and 0.83 percent students rated as very good.

Q5. Fairness of the internal evaluation process by teacher.

Analysis: 70.41 percent of the students observed the internal evaluation as always fair and 29.16 percent as usually fair and 0.41 percent rated as sometimes unfair.

Q6. Discussion of performance in assignments with you.

Analysis:99.16 percent students expressed that every time the assignment was conducted their performance was discussed 0.83 percent expressed usually.

Q7. The teacher takes active interest in arranging field visits for students. Promotion of internship student exchange field visit opportunities.

Analysis:98.75 percent student responded that the teacher takes active interest in arranging field visits for students and **1.25**percent students responded usually.

Q8. Teaching and mentoring process.

Analysis:67.08 percent and 32.91 percent students felt that mentoring process significally very well and good facilitated cognitive, social and emotional growth.

Q9. Institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow.

Analysis:99.58 percent and 0.41 percent students strongly agreed and agreed that the institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow.

Q10. Teacher informs about your expected competencies, course outcomes and programme outcomes.

Analysis:98.33 percent students **strongly expressed** that every time the teacher provides information and **1.66** percent **expressed normally.**

Q11. Follow up by mentor on task assigned.

Analysis:99.16 percent students expressed that every time the teacher mentors follow up on task assigned and **0.83** percent expressed usually.

Q12. Teachers illustrate the concepts through examples.

Analysis:77.5 percent students **strongly expressed** that every time the teachers illustrate the concept through examples and **22.5** percent **expressed usually**.

Q13. Teacher identifies your strength and encourage you with providing right level of challenges.

Analysis: 99.58 percent students strongly expressed that the teacher identifies their strength fully and encourage them with providing right level of challenges and 0.41 percent expressed reasonably.

Q14. Teachers are able to identify your weaknesses and help you to overcome them.

Analysis: 99.58 percent students strongly agreed that every time the teachers are able to identify them weaknesses and helped them to overcome and 0.41 percent agreed usually.

Q15. The institution makes effort to engage students in the monitoring review and continuous quality improvement of the teaching learning process.

Analysis: 98.75 percent and 1.25 percent of the students strongly agreed and agreed that the institution makes effort to engage students in the monitoring, review and continuous usually improvement of the teaching learning process.

Q16. The institute Teachers use student centric methods, such as experiential learning participative learning and problem-solving methods for enhancing learning experiences.

Analysis: 99.16 percent agreed to a great extent, 0.83 percent expressed moderate view.

Q17. Teachers encourage you to participate in extracurricular activities.

Analysis: **99.58**percent students strongly agreed that teachers encourage them to participate in extracurricular activities and **0.41** percent were neutral.

Q18. Efforts are made by the institute/teachers to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make you ready for the world of work.

Analysis:99.16 percent students expressed that the efforts are made by the institute/teachers to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make you ready for the world of work to a **great extent** and **0.83** percent expressed **moderate**.

Q19. What percentage of teachers uses ICT tools such as LCD projector, multimedia while teaching?

Analysis: 2.91 percent students gave their response as good and 44.58 percent gave response as very Good and 52.5 percent students gave response as excellent of teachers use ICT tools such as LCD projector, multimedia etc., while teaching.

Q20. The overall quality of teaching –learning process in you institute is very good.

Analysis:0.41 percent agreed and **99.53** strongly agreed to the overall quality of teaching —learning process in the institution/college.

Q21. Open end question for suggestions.

Analysis: Students have expressed their satisfaction and projected their desire for more
